

During the semester, the student may be awarded maximum 100 points:

- 60 points for one or more tests. One test will include elements of reading and listening comprehension. The tests will also include the specialist language.

- 40 points for different types of projects and assignments, including speaking tasks.

The awarded points are the confirmation of the learning outcomes LO1-LO3, according to the following scale:

Unsatisfactory (grade 2.0):

The student's overall score for the semester is below 51 points.

Satisfactory (grade 3.0):

The student's overall score for the semester is in the range of 51 - 60 points.

Satisfactory + (grade 3.5):

The student's overall score for the semester is in the range of 61 - 70 points.

Good (grade 4.0):

The student's overall score for the semester is in the range of 71 - 80 points.

Good + (grade 4.5):

The student's overall score for the semester is in the range of 81 - 90 points.

Excellent (grade 5.0)

The student's overall score for the semester is in the range of 91 - 100 points.

The semester ends with the final exam covering the material from all semesters.

The final grade is calculated according to the number of points:

Unsatisfactory (grade 2.0):

The student's score is below 51 percent of the points.

Satisfactory (grade 3.0):

The student's score is in the range of 51 - 60 percent of the points.

Satisfactory + (grade 3.5):

The student's score is in the range of 61 - 70 percent of the points.

Good (grade 4.0):

The student's score is in the range of 71 - 80 percent of the points.

Good + (grade 4.5):

The student's score is in the range of 81 – 90 percent of the points.

Excellent (grade 5.0)

The student's score is in the range of 91 - 100 percent of the points.
