

Principles of complete the course

Project:

RULES:

we do not record

attendance is obligatory (you may not be in two classes)

active participation in classes

the project should be delivered within 9 or 14 classes

you can correct the submitted project within 7 days

you can improve the test ONCE (the number of maximum points is reduced by 10)

if the project is not made independently - the subject will not be credited, which results in a 2.0 grade

the sample project is an example, do not copy it and replace the data!

the webcam should be turned on during the test

The evaluation includes 5 projects of the different stages of the project and test:

1 project	– 5
2 project	– 5
3 project	– 5
4 project	– 5
5 project	– 5
test	– 5

Deadline for the project will be specified in the first class.

If someone does not deliver the project on time, he gets a maximum of 4, more than 2 it is 3,5, more than 3 times is 3.

There is a maximum of 7 days to complete the missing project (after the deadline)
