Rules for crediting the course GENERAL BUILDING ENGINEERING II (19284106H):

LECTURE

The lecture ends with a written exam. There will be one retake exam. The condition for obtaining a positive grade is obtaining more than 50% of points. The following grading scale applies:

- 0-50% grade 2.0 (negative)
- 51-60% grade 3.0
- 61-70% grade 3.5
- 71-80% grade 4.0
- 81-90% grade 4.5
- 91-100% grade 5.0

PROJECT

Necessary conditions to obtain a positive grade in the course:

- 1. Execution of the project consisting of three drawings (vertical section and two details) and the calculation part (timber truss and masonry wall) according to the individual topics.
- 2. Passing the **written test**.

The Grade for the Course consists of two grades: 1° - the project (drawings and computational part); 2° - the final test. The final grade will be calculated as a weighted arithmetic mean value from these two grades. The weights for the particular components are:

- Grade for the project (drawings, timber truss and masonry wall) 75%
- Grade for the test 25%.

The grade for the project consists of 5 partial grades and is calculated as a **weighted arithmetic mean** value. The weight for all revisions is 40% and for the final project is 60% (10%+10%+10%+60%=100%).

Failure to submit the progress of work on the project within the deadline for revision/correction - Negative grade 2,0.

FINAL COURSE GRADE AND CREDITS

The student receives a positive grade and credit for the course only if he/she obtains a positive grade in both forms of classes - Lecture and Project. The student receives a positive grade (and credit) in the course only if all forms of classes are passed with a positive grade. The final grade for the course is calculated on the basis of the arithmetic average of grades from all forms of classes.
